Brown Bears / Unit 22

Current Regulations:

- ➤ 5 AAC 92.080 (4) Unlawful methods of taking game; exceptions.
 - ➤ In Unit 22, a snowmachine may be used to position a caribou, wolf, or wolverine for harvest, and caribou, wolves, or wolverines may be shot from a stationary snowmachine.
 - ➤ In bear control implementation areas, a snowmachine may be used to select an individual bear for harvest, and bears may be shot from a stationary snowmachine.
- Throughout the state, no regulation exists that permits hunters to use a snowmachine to position a bear for harvest.

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Brown Bears / Unit 22

Proposed Regulations:

- ➤ 5 AAC 92.080 (4) Unlawful methods of taking game; exceptions.
 - In Unit 22, a snowmachine may be used to position a <u>brown bear</u>, caribou, wolf, or wolverine for harvest, and <u>brown bears</u>, caribou, wolves, or wolverines may be shot from a stationary snowmachine.

Unit 22 Snowmachine Use

- ➤ Unit 22 Brown Bear Hunters: Average 32% hunted by snowmachine during RY2000-RY2018
 - > Resident Brown Bear Hunters: 38%
 - Nonresident Brown Bear Hunters: 28%
